Education Committee:

This committee will:

- Gather information about appropriate courses, the availability of courses, and make recommendations to the Local Union on whether or not members should be attending.
- Assist delegates in the preparation of reports to the membership on seminars and conferences and maintain a reference file of these reports.
- Co-operate with the Executive Board in preparing press releases and other publicity mater.
- Co-operate with the National Union Development Department and Communications Branch of CUPE, and with the regional Education Representative, in implementing both the Local Union's and CUPE's policies in these fields.
- Make recommendations and appoint selection committees for the purpose of bursaries. The committee is responsible for awarding such bursaries.

The committee members will be the elected chairperson and between two (20 to four (4) other members. The committee shall appoint its secretary from among its members.
