APPLY FOR 608 BURSARY FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING SCHOOLS OTHER THAN PENTICTON SECONDARY OR PRINCESS MARGARET

To apply for one of two available bursaries, please submit the following to the CUPE 608 Education Committee at the above mailing address or via e-mail to <u>education608@outlook.com</u> by May 15th in the year of graduation.

In awarding the bursary, the Committee will consider marks, needs and character.

Application requirements:

- 1. Student must be graduating from Grade 12 and heading into a full-time or vocational program in the fall.
- Student must submit a statement of approximately 300 words describing their vocational plans, including the cost of training, prospects of employment in future occupation, and any progress in preparation for same. Please indicate in your letter your relationship with CUPE 608.
- 3. Student must submit a copy of their Grade 11 letter grades and their most current letter grades for Grade 12.
- 4. Student must submit the names and phone numbers of two (2) references from a part-time employer or responsible citizen, outside of school staff or family.

Successful applicants will be notified by mail and scholarship monies will be forwarded upon verification of registration at an approved post-secondary institution.
